How Much May I Raise?

Participating in our Camp Worker Support program allows you the opportunity to raise an additional amount of money while you raise your prayer support. You can raise an additional 120% in excess of the amount that the camp will pay to you.

Please note that the amount you receive from CWS depends entirely upon how well you are able to do in raising your support.

Any amounts in excess of the amount you are eligible to receive will remain in the General Fund of CSSM ministries. At the end of the summer, a list of the people who have donated funds toward your support will be forwarded to you so that you can send them a thank you note as well as an update on your summer ministry.

What is C.W.S.?

Each of the eleven CSSM camps in Saskatchewan pays its workers a guaranteed wage per week less applicable deductions. We realize that this wage may not be enough to cover the expenses of some of our summer ministry team. The **Camp Worker Support** program allows you to raise extra income to help alleviate some of this problem. **CWS** operates within the Canada Revenue Agency guidelines. It is considered extra wage and therefore is subject to EI and CPP deductions.

Once we receive your application, we will be in touch with you to assist you in raising your support for summer ministry.

How do I qualify?

Applicants must be in Senior High, of Senior High age or older.

You must apply before June 1 or there must be special circumstances.

If attending school, please specify the name of the educational facility.

Once we receive your application, we will forward you a letter which you can copy and send out to your friends, family, church, and any other people who you feel may be interested in supporting your summer ministry with CSSM Ministries. This letter will verify your ministry with us this summer and advise of procedures to forward support directly to the Saskatchewan Branch of CSSM Ministries. A 15% fee will be deducted from donations in order to cover the employer's portion of EI, CPP, Worker's Comp., and Liability Insurance.

Please plan on having all donations received in our office by August 15th as once we close the C.W.S. program for the year, subsequent donations will be returned to the donor.
